Project Goals

With this Website and application, our users will be able to locate all recipes in a central location that is easy to share. The SpEcial Company provides a particular website and application to allocate detailed recipes that can be purchased, uploaded, or viewed. In doing so, we hope our users will share their recipes with others on and off the platform. Our Website and application contain original recipes and instructions for all types, including but not limited to pescatarians, vegans, and vegetarians.

Alternatives

- The Standalone application will grant users access to save their recipes and share them with others on or off the application.
- The Website will permit users to save and share recipes, but the administration will screen recipes to prevent duplication and other unauthorized uploads.
- The Digital eBook will be updated monthly, similar to a magazine subscription.

Financial Planning for Application

The SpECial Company's initial startup cost would be approximately \$600,000 to \$800,000 to design, develop, and layout for both the app and the Website. The initial operating cost of the company is roughly \$300,000 to \$400,000, where the three CEO make an initial investment of \$5,000 each. Once the company is on the way, there will be a year-over-year increase investment of approximately 30%. To start seeing a profit, it will take 1-1/2 years to return on investment of about \$1.1 million.


This initial investment will need to be approximately \$1.1 million and some of the different sources to get funding:
